

## Opening Files in Windows Notepad Article #1010

These instructions are provided for users needing to open a file (.ini, .go, .opt) in Windows Notepad. Instructions and screen grabs shown in this document have been created using Windows 98.

- Open Windows Notepad by clicking the Start button, Programs, Accessories, Notepad.
- 2. Click File > Open
- 3. Under Files of Type, select All Files.




4. Under Look in, select the drive and directory where the file is located. In this example, the file FANUCSMD.GO is located in the C:\DENFORD folder.

5. Click the name of the file then click the Open button.



- 6. Edit the file as needed. When complete, if changes were made, save the file by clicking File > Save.
- 7. Close Notepad by clicking File > Exit.
